Why Aegion? Why now?

In every company's evolution, there are inflection points — moments that signal a major shift in strategy. Insituform reached just such a point in 2011 when, for the first time in our history, our global sewer contracting business will represent less than 50 percent of our revenue, after representing approximately 88 percent of our revenue in 2007.

This was no accident. Rather, it reflects the success of our plan to diversify into higher growth and higher return products and services. By 2012, we anticipate our North American sewer rehabilitation business will represent less than one-third of our revenue as growth in our global Energy and Mining businesses and our Commercial and Structural group accelerates.

So, answering the *Why Now?* question is easy.

The Insituform® name represents where we came from, and the Aegion™ name represents what we have become and, more importantly, where we are going.

But *Why Aegion?*

Finding a new name is no easy task. So we drew on Greek mythology to create one. Aegion is a combination of two words: "Aegis" is the protective shield used by Zeus, king of the gods. "Eon" suggests a long period of time. Together they form "Aegion", a company that develops and provides high quality products to protect infrastructure through the ages.

With a name like Aegion, we are driven to think more broadly than before.

It demands that we provide a "protective shield" for sewer, water, oil and gas pipelines, buildings, roads, bridges, dams and other infrastructure — whether this infrastructure is newly installed, at the end of its useful life, or somewhere in between. ... Growth Outlook?

Thanks to our diversification strategy, our growth outlook has never been stronger. By stretching beyond our historical business of sewer rehabilitation, we have completed acquisitions that broaden our product and service offering and provide a more meaningful presence in new market segments.

While growth in our long-standing sewer rehabilitation business is expected to be low (within North America) in the near term, **moderate to high growth** is expected in our **Energy & Mining** platform and **high growth** is expected in our newly established **Commercial & Structural** platform. In fact, by the end of 2012, we anticipate our North American rehabilitation business will represent less than one-third of our revenue as growth in these other businesses accelerates and we add higher return products and services to serve them.

... Business Opportunities?

While cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) contracting services are still important to our business, today we are “shielding the world’s infrastructure” in ways that go **far beyond CIPP**. We have added pipe coating, cathodic protection, fiber-reinforced polymer composites, engineering and other services that make it possible for us to construct, replace, protect and rehabilitate pipelines and commercial structures throughout the world. We are looking for **opportunities to grow** our industrial contracting business, to increase sales of our CIPP tubes to third parties worldwide and to expand our reach even further in the Middle East, Asia and Australia.

We are thinking “**outside the pipe**,” as we seek to protect buildings, roads, bridges, dams and other infrastructure from the effects of aging as well.

Our company gave birth to the CIPP rehabilitation industry 40 years ago and has been a leading provider of municipal pipeline rehabilitation ever since, with a reach that extends from North America to Europe and Asia-Pacific. Aegion today is a **leader** in other market segments as well.
